1. Full Name

Enter your full legal name.

Which pronouns do you use? (e.g., she/her, they/them)

1. School Name

Tell us the name of your school.

In what city or town is your school located?

3. **School Type** Is it a Public, Charter, Private, Religious, or Home School?

4. Year in School

What year are you currently in? (Sophomore, Junior)

Reference (Optional):

1. Reference Name

Provide the name of an adult (teacher, coach, etc.) who knows you well.

2. Relationship to You

How do they know you?

3. **Reference Phone and Email**

Their contact details.

Written Prompts (250 words each):

1. Identity

Describe a facet of your identity that is meaningful to you. Why is it important to you?

2. Community

Describe your community. Why does it matter to you and the country?

3. Values

Choose one of Citizen University's core values (Responsibility, Equity, Spirit, Purpose, Ingenuity, Collaboration, Trust) and explain why it resonates with you.

Creative Prompts:

1. Civic Power

What does "Civic Power" mean to you? You can either write or upload a creative response (video, poem, drawing, song, etc.).

2. American Identity

What does being American mean to you? You can either write or submit a creative response.

Program Commitment:

1. Cohort Preference

Would you prefer to join the Winter (December 2024 – April 2025) or Summer (May 2025 – October 2025) cohort?

2. Travel Availability

Each Youth Collaboratory Cohort will travel to two in-person gatherings. These gatherings are a required part of the Youth Collaboratory commitment. Please check each box to indicate that you are available to travel on the following dates in 2025:
